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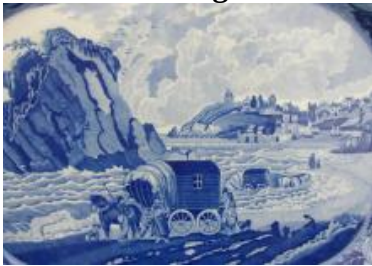

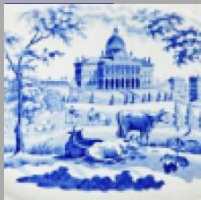
An earthenware platter printed in blue in the Monk's Rock Series, Tenby pattern. Minton designed the pattern from a scene depicted in Middiman's "Select Views of Great Britain" published in 1813. The large rock, also known by the Norse name Giltar or Gildar, is commonly called Monk's Rock, due probably to an association with a Benedictine priory on nearby Caldey Island.
