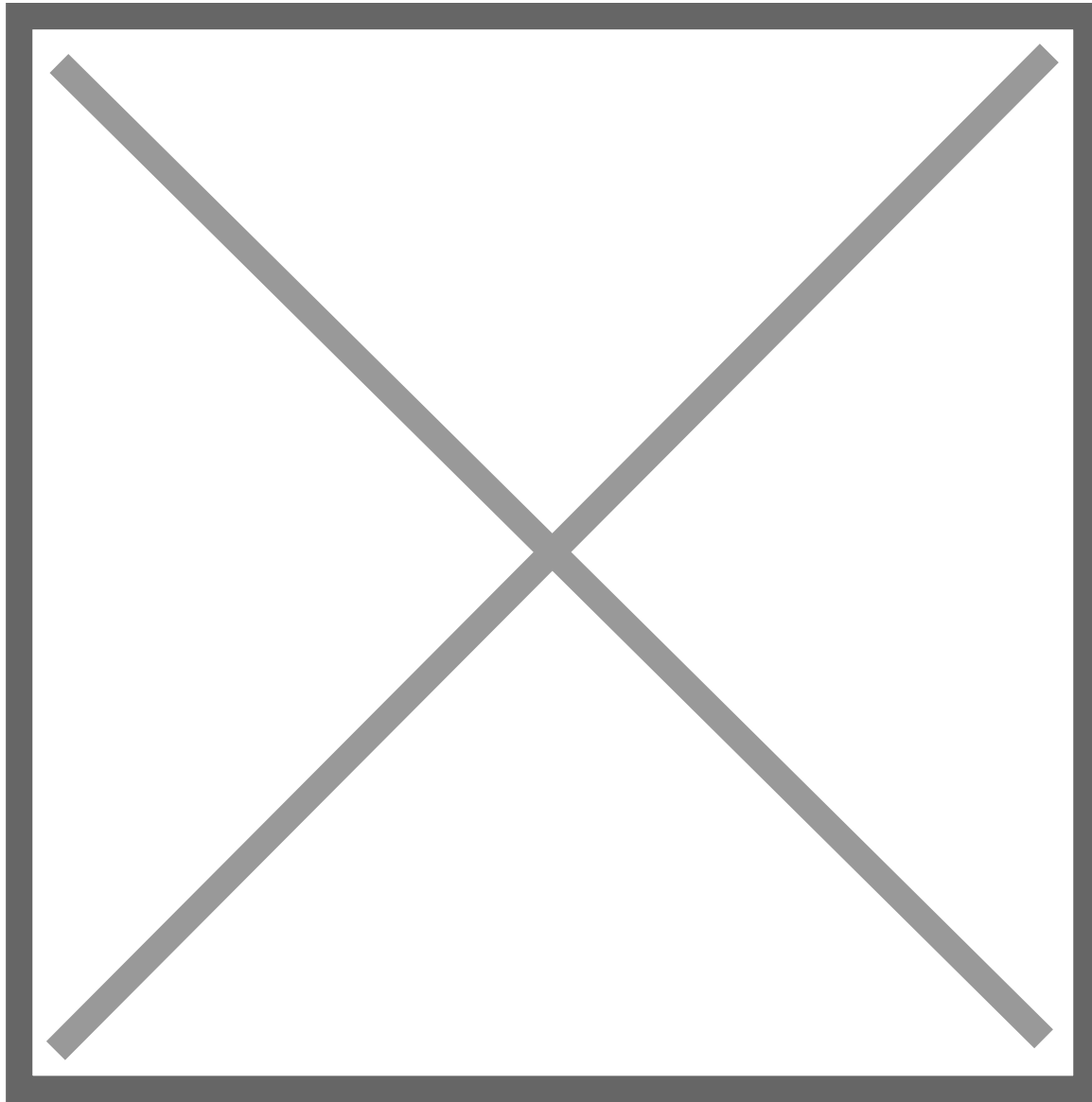


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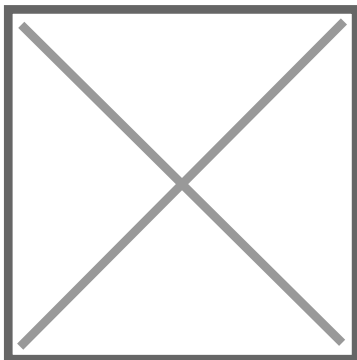

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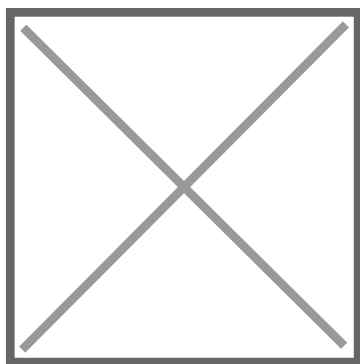

The outer border is printed with the Butterfly pattern. The inner border is an unknown Chinoiserie design.
