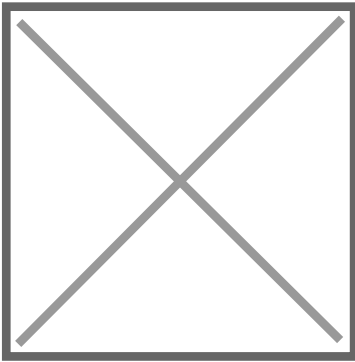

This Bow jug is printed in overglaze red with Blind Man's Buff (shown here), Marbles and Battledore and Shuttlecock. These prints are based on engravings of about 1750 by Jacques Bacheley after designs by Gravelot. These designs also appear on Worcester porcelain.
