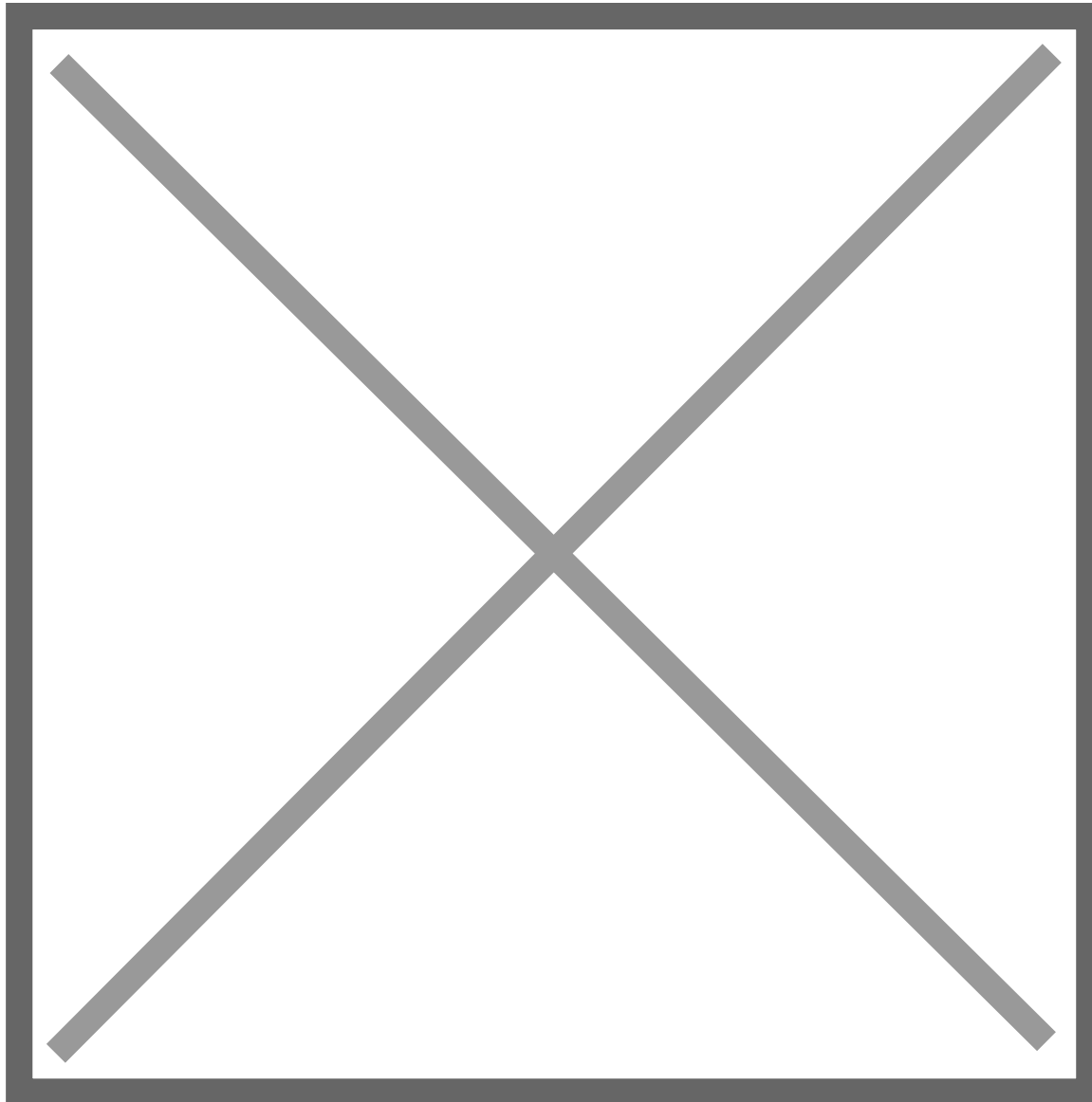

Earthenware tiles printed with scenes from the series 'Times of the Day and Months'.
