Description:

An earthenware platter printed in blue with a pattern known as Mare and Foal. Although the source print has not been identified, the center pattern resembles the work of Samuel Howitt (ca. 1756-1822), a painter, illustrator and etcher of animals. Howitt's work was used in some of the other Quadrupeds' patterns. Three of the animals in the border cartouches were copied from A Cabinet
