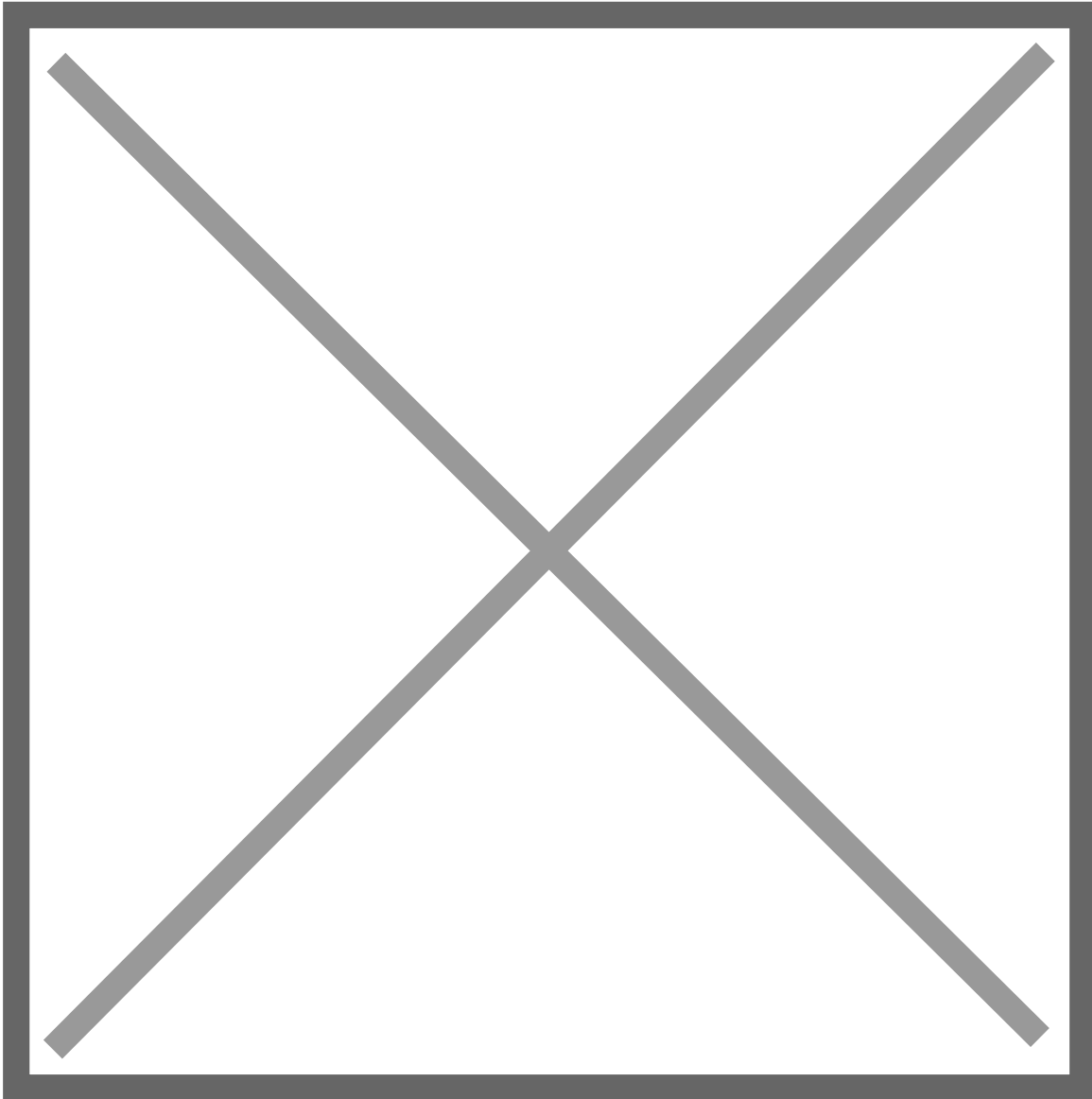

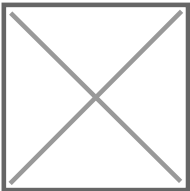

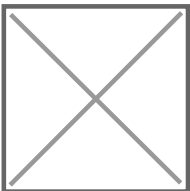

An earthenware platter printed in brown and painted-in underglaze. The pattern name, Cyprus, is printed on the underside with the factory mark. An additional impressed mark was added with the name "Ivory" which would refer to the factory's name for their earthenware body.
