EARTHENWARE MERCHANT, WAREHOUSE & SHOW ROOM, 49 CHAPEL STREET, SOUTHPORT". The amusing placement of the word "AND", intended to appear between "GLASS" and "CHINA" was probably done to achieve symmetry of design on

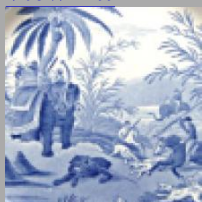
