



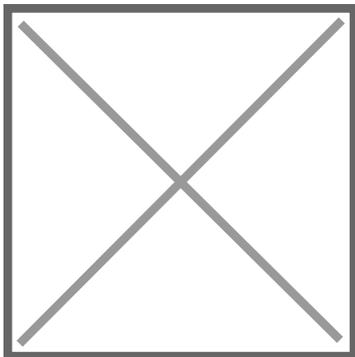

Description:

This Bow porcelain dish is printed with a brown outline print that has then been filled in with enamel colors. A number of designs at Bow were based on printed outlines that were intended then to be painted to complete the pattern. The central design on this dish is known as *Two Chinese Women Choosing Accessories*. The rim is printed with two scenes of Chinese figures
