




This Derby porcelain mug is printed in puce with a half length portrait of the King of Prussia in armour. This print is flanked by prints of a butterfly and and a floral spray. This mug is the only extant example of puce printed Derby porcelain, although Chaffers refers in Marks and Monograms to a Derby cup printed in lilac with the King of Prussia.
