

### **Description:**

An earthenware soup plate printed in blue underglaze and enameled overglaze in red and green with flowers and leaves painted onglaze. The pattern is known as Dragon. A pseudo Chinese symbol is printed in blue by an unknown maker on the back. This pattern is based on a Chinese original design.
