This octagonal aesthetic movement earthenware plate is printed in dark brown and painted underglaze in shades of fuchsia or red, golden yellow, green and blue. The pattern features exotic blooming orchids and wildflowers mixed with fern fronds surrounding two cartouches; one of The Customs House in Boston.
