


## **Description:**

A miniature earthenware plate printed in dark blue with the Standard Willow pattern. This small plate was made as a trade card for the Newcastle retailer Richard Stanway. On the front the pattern is overwritten by a scroll with the inscription: "RICHARD STANWAY, NEWCASTLE STAFFS." A small hole at the top edge suggests that it may have been attached to garments made by the *expand* [+]
