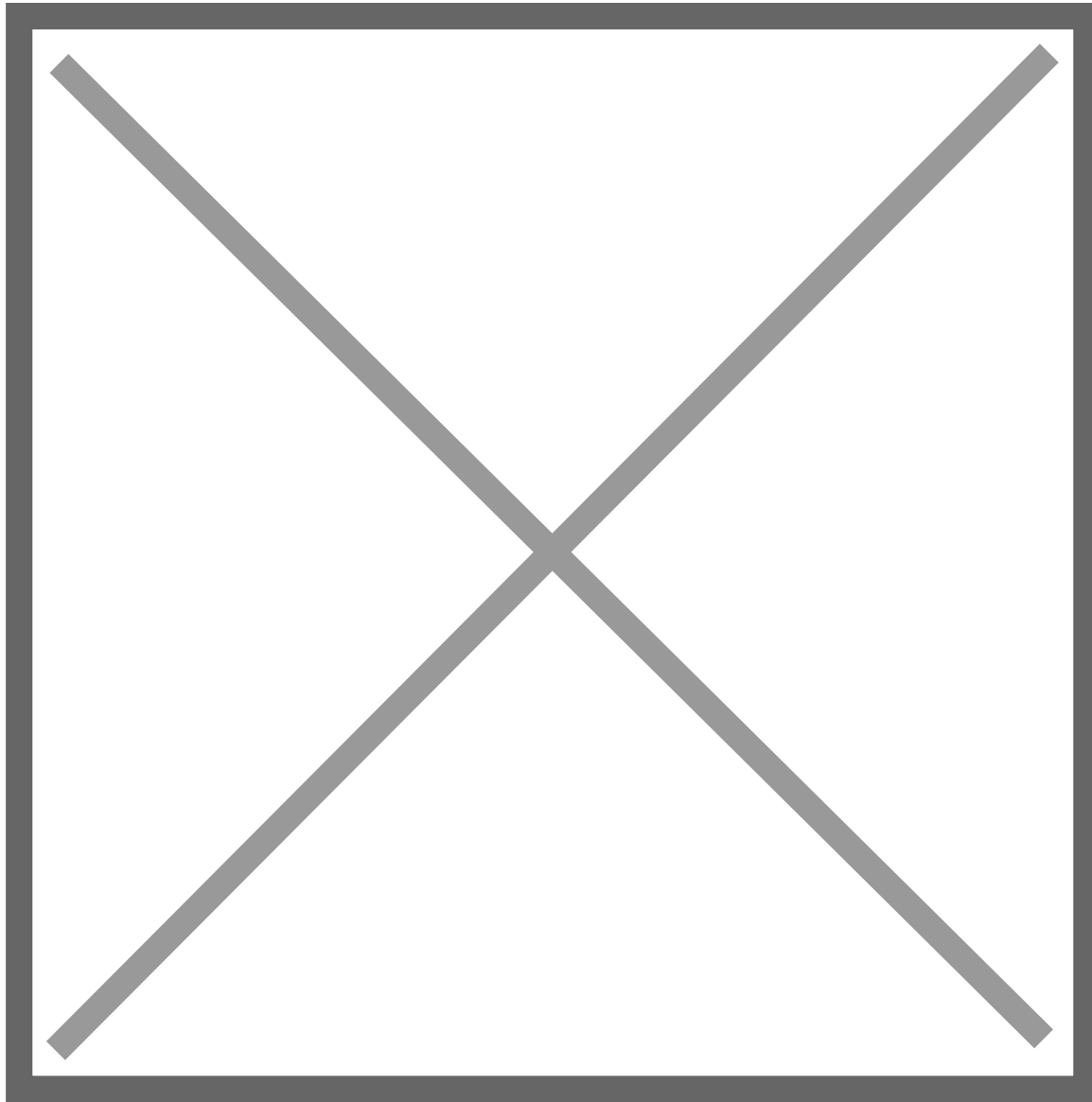

A stoneware jug of narrow waisted form with printed portraits of Admiral of the Fleet Sir Hedworth Meux (formerly Lambton) (1856-1929) inscribed "CAPT. H. LAMBTON" Admiral Sir Percy Moreton Scott (1853-1924) inscribed "CAPT. P.M. SCOTT" and a rating from 'HMS Powerful' inscribed "THE·HANDY·MAN". It commemorates the activities of the Naval Brigade in the South African War in 1899 and the role of Scott and *expand* [+]

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
