

A molded earthenware pouch vase printed in blue with the Elephant variation of Buffalo pattern. This late 18th century line-engraved pattern has most of the elements of the popular Buffalo pattern except that the boy mounted on the buffalo is replaced by an enchanting baby elephant without a rider. It is rare for an early hollow ware piece like this one to be marked. expand [+]


