


Description:

A rare pearlware obelisk-shaped ornamental printed in blue with small portions of a Chinoiserie pattern and with a butterfly or moth motif border printed on the molded base and top of the plinth both of which have been identified as Minton's Trench Mortar pattern. This type of ornamental can frequently be found with overglaze painted designs, but late 18th century underglaze printed examples are *expand* [+]


