


A large earthenware punch pot printed in blue in an unidentified landscape pattern and a floral border. Of interest, in addition to its size, is the use of a small pattern that is repeated six or more times in order to cover the entire body of the pot. It appears that the maker chose to use a pattern originally made for a smaller item *expand* [+]
