

## **Description:**

Brown print & color washes, makers mark "TA SIMPSON / STOKE-ON-TRENT". The tile is decorated with shell motifs and it is possible the design was intended for use on a fireplace, perhaps in a bathroom. The demand for wall tiles increased rapidly in the later 19th century. One of the most popular uses of tiles, of the type shown here, was in conjunction with fireplaces.
