



Description:

A large molded earthenware soup tureen with cover printed in blue in a Chinoiserie revival pattern named by the pottery as Ceylon Temple. Prior to the discovery of an example with the pattern name printed on it, the design had been referred to as Floral Horse. The maker of this pattern is unknown, however, at least one example is known with a printed retailer's *expand* [+]
