

An earthenware cup plate printed in blue in the Hyena or Striped Hyena pattern. The cup plate is not marked. The cup plate size varies from 3.38 inches to 4.25 inches. The Hyena pattern is also found in the bowl of the sauce tureen ladle (7 inches in length with a 2.5 *expand* [+]
