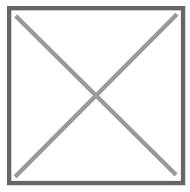

During the 16th century it passed into the hands of Sir Thomas More and his family. The building shown here was designed by James Gibb in the early 18th century and was surrounded by a *expand* [+]
