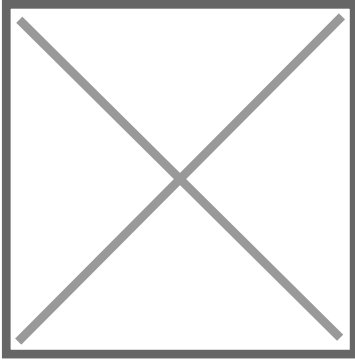

This is a one shilling token issued by the Worcester Porcelain Company. It is printed in black enamel with an inscription: I promise to pay to the Bearer on demand one Shilling W Davis At the China Factory. Another, larger, token was issued for two shillings. This was also black printed. The factory appears to have issued these tokens during a period from about 1780 when regular
